#### 300,000<sup>th</sup> QOV Award –

During the Elks Vietnam War Veterans Event on Friday, 3/25/22, LCQOV made its Honorary 300,000<sup>th</sup> QOV award in recognition of reaching a milestone—the 300,000<sup>th</sup> Quilt of Valor awarded nationwide. A number was randomly-selected by my husband, and Terry Prangley, who happened to be #11 on our awards list, was the recipient. Terry served in the U.S. Army from 1973-1978. His quilt was pieced and bound by Dawna Glenn, and quilted by Corla Hughes. He was most appreciative of this additional honor. He said, “I’d serve all over again if I could.”

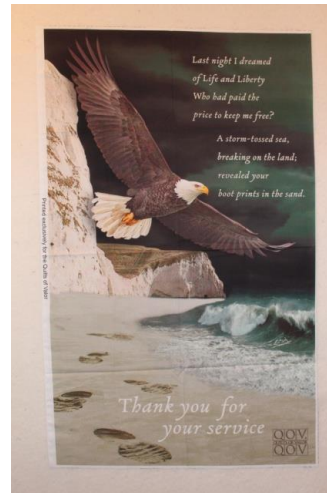
